

AEMC's New Board Takes Office

On 24 January 2023, the new AEMC governing bodies for the 2023-2026 triennium were elected at the Hotel Vip. The ceremony was attended by His Excellency the Minister of Industry and Trade Engineer Silvino Moreno, the Director of the UFSA Dr Albertina Furquia and representatives of the companies affiliated to the AEMC.

The Association of Mozambican Consultancy Companies (AEMC) will be chaired by engineer Sarifa Izidine, representing TÉCNICA - Engenheiros Consultores, replacing architect Bruno Vedor.
